



## Quick Connect Guide For Meeting Participants

### SAR-NET Meeting Information

This information will help you to connect to the SAR-NET meeting room that you have been invited to. If you follow the steps in this document you should be able to collaborate online with people from anywhere.

#### You will need:

- An internet connection  
LAN or any DSL connection is preferred as all rooms are set up for DSL.
- A web browser
- Adobe Flash Player

*If you are using 3G or Dial up connection please inform your meeting host at the beginning of the meeting*

#### It's nice to have:

- A webcam
- A headset with microphone
- Or speakers
- If you are not on a fast connection you may notice some lag on your webcam and / or headset microphone

#### You can meet without the nice to have's:

- You can use a telephone call, or conference call, for the audio component if discussion is required.
- SAR-NET also provides a chat feature which allows you to communicate by text with others in the meeting.

### SAR-NET will work on your PC, Laptop, Tablet or Smartphone

### SAR-NET Meeting Information

#### MS Windows, Apple Mac and MacBook

- Use the internet browser to go to the meeting URL
- Enter the room as a Guest
  - Use the radio button to select Enter as Guest
  - Type your name in the field and Click Enter Room

#### Android

- Go to the Google Play Store and search Adobe Connect
- Download the app
- Open the app and enter the meeting URL, keep the tick in Secure Login
- Enter the room as a Guest
  - Use the radio button to select Enter as Guest
  - Type your name in the field and click Enter Room

#### Apple iPad

- Download the Adobe Connect app from the Apple iTunes Store
- Open the app and enter the meeting URL, keep the tick in Secure Login
- Enter the room as a Guest
  - Use the radio button to select Enter as Guest
  - Type your name in the field and click Enter Room

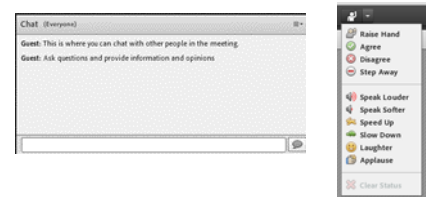
### Enter the Meeting Room

A request will be sent to the meeting host.

When accepted, the meeting room will open and you will enter the room with participant privileges.

#### As a participant you can:

- Be involved in the text chat in the chat pod
- Change your status using the flag menu



#### The meeting host can give you:

##### Access to the audio features

*You will need to set up your microphone using the audio setup wizard*

- Click the microphone icon and select connect my audio
  - Click allow on the flash player message
- Click the Meeting button and select Audio setup wizard
  - Run through the entire wizard to get optimum performance



##### Access to the video features

- Click the webcam icon and select Start my webcam
  - You will see a preview of your webcam image  
Adjust your camera angle, lighting and any settings while in the preview mode
- Click Start Sharing to share your image



##### Permission to use some of the advanced sharing features in the room

*When they set the permissions they will give you verbal or written guidance of how to use the features*
